It was determined based on observation that five staff had expired satisfactory letters on file.

The Center will ensure that each director and employee hired after January 1, 2014 has a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination dated within 12 months of the hire date and will submit the required documents to obtain the determination if they have not already done so. The center completed the new cogent process. They submitted the background application to the department on this date.

Finding

591-1-1-.14(1) requires the Center Director to successfully complete a biennial training program in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and a triennial training program in first aid that is conducted by certified or licensed health care professionals and deals with the provision of emergency care to infants and children. In addition, at least fifty percent (50%) of the caregiver Staff shall have completed such training at any given time. It was determined based on review of staff files that the center did not have staff with current first aid and CPR.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center director and at least 50% of the caregiver Staff will complete the needed training. The director will send written verification to the consultant upon completion and will develop a plan to ensure that at least 50% of the caregiver Staff have completed this training at any given time.
