If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)1 requires that cots and mats are of sound construction and of sufficient size to accommodate comfortably the size and weight of the child; and that mats are in good repair, washable, covered with a waterproof material and at least two inches (2") thick. It was determined based on consultant observed that the cots in Room B, C and E (right) were torn and not in good repair.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that cots and mats are of sound construction and of sufficient size to accommodate the size and weight of the child and mats are in good repair, washable, covered with a waterproof material and is at least two inches thick.

591-1-1-.33(4) requires the Director and person with primary responsibility for food preparation to have four clock hours of training in food nutrition planning, preparation, serving, proper dish washing and food storage. It was determined based on consultant observation that the cook only has two of four hours of the four hours of required training.

Staffing and Supervision

Finding

591-1-1-.32(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined based on consultant observation that the right room in building two was out of ratio when the ratio was one staff member to 17 children and the ratio should have been one staff member to 15 children. The classroom initially had two staff members and while consultants were on the visit one staff member left the room on two different occasions.

To ensure adequate Staff:child ratios in mixed age groups. The Center will maintain ratios.
