591-1-1-.32(4) requires that children under three years old be housed in separate physical areas from older children except during early morning arrival and late afternoon departure times. It was determined, based on an investigation that a one-year-old child was discovered by center staff on the preschool playground playing with the three-year-old children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times. It was determined, based on an investigation that center staff did not see when a one-year-old child entered the preschool playground with the three-year-old children.

The center will provide training to staff and monitor to ensure that children are supervised at all times.
