If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation of five children files that two of the files were incomplete.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will develop a plan that includes how to obtain all required information for currently enrolled children and how to ensure this is done for future enrollees as well. The plan will also include how and where to maintain files for the required amount of time. The plan will be implemented and followed.

(c) Any transportation training completed should be state approved or state accepted training. It was determined based on observation that the director did not have evidence of having completed transportation training.

The center will ensure that the director, center staff, and any person responsible for the transportation of children has completed the required transportation training.
