591-1-1-.18(8) prohibits children from being in the kitchen except as part of a planned, supervised learning experience. Children were observed in the kitchen; no learning experience was taking place. It was determined based on a complaint investigation that children were in the kitchen with one staff member in the morning of March 27, 2017, while the staff member was preparing breakfast.

The center will ensure that children's access to the kitchen is restricted as required.
