591-1-1-.17(2) requires that Personnel, to the extent possible, keep children clean, dry and comfortable. It was determined based on consultant's investigative findings on March 23, 2017 a four-year-old child sustained discomfort when hot tea was spilled on their forehead and left arm.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that staff are responsive to children's needs to be clean, dry and comfortable, the center will ensure that staff members are not drinking hot liquids in the presence of children. The center will also ensure that all hot liquids are inaccessible to children receiving care.
