If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. #### Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(e) requires every Employee hired before January 1, 2014 have either a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination or a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination on file and requires that Employees hired before January 1, 2014 that have only a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination on file to obtain a Fingerprint Records Check Determination before January 1, 2017. It was determined based on consultant's review of staff files two of three staff members did not have evidence of a satisfactory determination letter on file on this date. Consultant observed one of three staff members to have a date of hire documented for December 8, 1998 and a satisfactory local criminal records check dated for October 22, 2001. Consultant also observed one of three staff members to have a date of hire documented for February 15, 2000 and a satisfactory local criminal records check dated for February 14, 2000. A one-day letter was left on this date.

The Center will ensure that every employee hired before January 1, 2014 has a satisfactory preliminary determination or satisfactory fingerprint determination on file and will have a plan to ensure that these employees obtain a Fingerprint Records Check Determination before January 1, 2017.
