If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.25(13) requires that hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be inaccessible to children. It was determined based on consultant observation that unsafe storage of materials dangerous to children was observed as follows: in Room 203 potting mix was on the teacher's desk, and cottonelle wipes in a child backpack in Room 229 that both read 'keep out of reach of children. It was further determined In Room 125 in a cubby two bottles of baby sunscreen and aquaphor were accessible to children. In room 123 a toy had the batteries taken out and the batteries were out and accessible.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will ensure all potential hazards are inaccessible to children.
