If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that there was less than three inches of mulch under the swing on the far right of the play area and the swings closet to the parking lot..

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that climbing and swinging equipment is anchored. The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.
