591-1-1-.25(9) requires that the Center not allow a person to remain on the premises if the person does not have a legitimate reason for being on the premises. It was determined, based on an investigative that sometime near the end of February, the beginning of March, 2018, center staff allowed a twelve-year-old child to freely interact at will with the children in care and assist center staff as needed in the classrooms. is substantiated.

The Center will monitor persons who enter the Center and ask them to leave when required.

591-1-1-.05 Animals Not Met

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.05(2) requires Center Staff to confine animals in pens or covered areas except during specific teacher-directed learning experiences and to keep animal pens and confinement areas clean. It was determined, based on an investigation that the owner/director's two dogs were present on playground C which is adjacent to other playgrounds B and D during hours of operation while children were in care at the facility.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will maintain and keep animals in a suitable pen or covered area except when a teacher is using the animal in a specific learning experience. If needed, the pen or covered area will be cleaned and the Center will develop and follow a plan to keep the area clean.
