If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.08(a)-(f) requires Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled that includes the following information: (a) child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; (b) names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; (c) name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone number, relationship to child and other identifying information; (d) name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; (e) name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and (f) known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on consultant's review of the children's files four of five children's files did not have documentation of known allergies, one of five children's files did not have documentation, and one of five children's files did not have documentation of the emergency contact persons. It was further determined based on consultant's review of the children's files one of five children's files did not have documentation of the name and address for the parents' work and home numbers, one of five children's files did not have documentation of the name and address for the release to persons, and five of five children's files did not have documentation of the parents' work address.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will develop a plan that includes how to obtain all required information for currently enrolled children and how to ensure this is done for future enrollees as well. The plan will also include how and where to maintain files for the required amount of time. The plan will be implemented and followed.

Finding

591-1-1-.06(4) requires a Center first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that remodel or add to existing plumbing facilities, to have the bathroom area fully enclosed and ventilated to the outside of the building with either an open screened window or functioning exhaust fan and duct system and requires Centers without fully enclosed bathrooms to ensure there is adequate ventilation to control odors and adequate sanitation measures to prevent the spread of contagious diseases. It was determined based on consultant's observation the ventilation in the restrooms located in the Grasshoppers classroom and the Beetles classroom were observed to be inoperable on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will fully enclose and ventilate bathroom areas, as required, and will provide adequate ventilation and sanitation in bathrooms that are not fully enclosed.

Finding

591-1-1-.19(1) requires the Center to provide 35 square feet of usable space per child. It was determined based on consultant's observation the center cared for 14 one year old in a space that was licensed for 12 children in the upstairs Ladybug classroom. It was further determined based on consultant's observation the center cared for 14 one and two year old in a space that was licensed for 11 children in the upstairs Firefly classroom.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will limit the number of children in this space to the licensed capacity.

It was determined based on consultant's observation unsafe storage of materials hazardous to children were observed as follows: classroom upstairs-Pre-K-consultant observed a staff member's purse to be sitting in a chair across from the stairs and a stapler and two pair of adult size scissors were observed to be sitting on a table on the back right side of the classroom. All items were observed to be accessible to the children receiving care on this date.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will store all hazardous items and/or materials in a locked cabinet and/or container inaccessible to the children receiving care.

It was determined based on consultant's review of the center's infant feeding plans the center did not have a feeding plan for one infant.
