If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.25(3) requires that the Center and surrounding premises be clean, free of debris and in good repair. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the following areas/items were found to be noncompliant:

- -The plumbing for the sink in the three year old room malfunctioned which caused a light steam of water to flow from the faucet.
- -The light in the girls' bathroom in the cafeteria was not working.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will repair the sink and light.

The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the resilient surface under the large play structures measured less than six inches.

The Center will ensure that climbing and swinging equipment is anchored. The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.

Finding

591-1-1-.14(1) requires the Center Director to successfully complete a biennial training program in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and a triennial training program in first aid that is conducted by certified or licensed health care professionals and deals with the provision of emergency care to infants and children. In addition, at least fifty percent (50%) of the caregiver Staff shall have completed such training at any given time. It was determined based on review of records that less than fifty percent (50%) of the caregiver staff had current documentation of CPR/first aid training on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center director and at least 50% of the caregiver Staff will complete the needed training. The director will send written verification to the consultant upon completion and will develop a plan to ensure that at least 50% of the caregiver Staff have completed this training at any given time.
