591-1-1-.08(4) requires Center Staff to consider information pertaining to children confidential and not to release such information without first obtaining written permission signed by the Parents except to share relevant information among caregivers, with members of the Department or with other persons authorized by these rules or the law to receive such information, or with other persons in an emergency situation involving the child. It was determined based on review of director and parent text messages from cell phone, that information was posted on a parent facebook messenger sharing a child's dis-enrollment from the center. It was further determined that photos of a child was shared on facebook without permission from the parent.
