Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.36(4)(f)1. requires that all transported children be secured in a child passenger restraining system or seat safety belt in accordance with current state and federal laws and regulations and according to manufacturer's directions.

It was determined based on review of vehicle safety restraints that the center transported 18 children on April 24, 2017 and 22 children on April 25, 2017. The vehicle in use was equipped with 13 safety restraints.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that manufacturer directions and state and federal laws are met when using child passenger restraining systems and seat safety belts.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(4)(f)2. requires that no vehicle shall exceed the manufacturer's rated seating capacity and that proof of the seating capacity is maintained on file.

It was determined based on review of records that on April 24, 2017 the Center transported a total of 22 children in a vehicle with a seating capacity of 13 and on April 25, 2017 the Center transported a total of 18 children in a vehicle with a seating capacity of 13.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The manufacturer's rated seating capacity will not be exceeded and a copy of the manufacturer's seating capacity will be maintained on file at all times.

.36(7)(c)2. - Previous citation was corrected in that the Consultant observed all children were appropriately marked present or abscent on transportation documentation.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(7)(d)2. requires that the second designated Staff person conduct a check of the vehicle immediately upon the completion of the first check of the vehicle. There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. The second designated Staff person must complete the following: (i) Physically walk through the entire vehicle; (ii) Visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; and (iii) Sign the passenger transportation checklist (s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle.

It was determined based a review of records that a second check of the vehicle was not documented May 17, 2017 and May 18, 2017 from Garrison and on May 19, 2017 from EOA, Haven Elementary, Juilette Low Elementary, Southwest Elementary and Gould Elementary.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that the second responsible staff person checks the vehicle immediately after the first check has been completed.
