Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.29(1)(c) requires the center to report to the Department within twenty-four hours or the next work day any child's death while in care; any serious illness/injury requiring professional medical attention; any situation when a child in care becomes missing; any fire; any structural disaster; and any emergency requiring temporary relocation of children. It was determined based on investigative findings that on May 11, 2017, the center failed to properly report an injury to a seven-month-old infant that required professional medical attention. The center was made aware of the child's visit, but did not believe the injury occurred at the center and therefore did not report it to the Department.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that a report to the Department takes place when required, the center will report all incidents and injuries to the department as required.
