591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined on this date through the consultant's observation that a tree stump was protruding from the ground creating a potential tripping hazard and a wooden barrier to the right of the slide was splintering.

#### Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.10(3)(a) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper change surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined on this date through the consultant's observation that the changing pad in room A had several tears not allowing the surface to be properly disinfected as required. This citation observed to be corrected.

\*However, it was determined on this date through the consultant's observation that the changing pad in room A was quilted and not nonporous as required preventing the changing pad to be properly sanitized as required.

591-1-1.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined on this date through the consultant's observation that the changing pad in room A was quilted and not nonporous as required preventing the changing pad to be properly sanitized as required.
