This Monitoring Visit is the first regulatory visit for Lil' Angels Daycare and Kindergarten this 2019 - 2020 fiscal year. The provider stated no medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided. The center currently has a one star Quality Rating.

Seven staff new staff was hired since the consultant's last visit. The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file.
