It was determined based on observation potential hazards were observed in Classroom H and Classroom I. The Consultant observed a drill, Sharpie permanent markers, and a staff person's backpack in the unlocked closet in Classroom I. The Consultant observed baby oil and a staff person's bag in the unlocked closet in Classroom H.

### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.
