Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on an investigation that inadequate supervision was being provided on July 25, 2019, when a three-year-old child was injured when they slipped off of the top stair on the spiral staircase on the playground while wearing a helmet and was caught on the equipment by the helmet. Professional medical attention was obtained.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
