#### Comments

This Monitoring Visit is the first reguatory visit for Krayons Academy this 2017 - 2018 fiscal year.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and It was determined based on the consultant's review of all staff files that one staff member was hired August 9, 2017 and has a satisfactory criminal background check with BFTS which expires August 5, 2020. However the portability of the criminal background checkk expired August 5, 2015. The employee has not been reprinted. Additionally, a second employee was hired on September 9, 2014 and has an incorrect reason code which was to be reprinted within 90 days of September 9, 2014. Additionally, a third employee was hired August 31, 2017 and has no local background check or satisfactory criminal records check on file as required. A one day letter was provided to the center director and the consultant advised that the three employees can't return to the center pending the receipt of a satisfactory finger print criminal records check clearance determination letter.

The center director stated no field trips have been taken since the last regulatory visit and no medication has been provided. Transportation is provided. The center director stated the center provides liability insurance.

No infants are enrolled.

The center currently has a two star Quality Rating.

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the white and red rope used as a hand rail and located on the wooden walk plank of the wooden gym set is weathered and frayed, leaving strings which are accessible to the children.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Correction Deadline: 9/10/2017

#### Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the gate leading to the single air condition unit located in the back left side of the building and within the child playground area was not locked.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
