Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that there were three to five inch gaps at the bottom of the fence on the back of the School age playground exposing sharp, exposed wires.
