Comments

This Licensing Study is the second regulatory visit for First Steps Infant / Toddler Center this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year.

The center director stated the center has received a three star Quality Rating since the consultant's last visit. The center does not administer medication, no field trips or routine transportation is provided.

The Lighthouse Early Start Academy (CCLC-2304) is undergoing renevation and the children are housed at First Steps Infant / Toddler Center (CCLC-12891). Children and staff enrolled at The Lighthouse Early Start Academy are counted in with the child / staff ratio of children enrolled at First Steps Infant / Toddler Center and documented on the LS for The Lighthouse Early Start Academy.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
