Comments

This Monitoring Visit is the first regulatory visit for First Steps Infant / Toddler Center this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year.

The center currently has a three star Quality Rating.

The center director stated no medication is administered, no swimming, field trips or routine transportation is provided.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. The consultant discussed with the center director that effective October 1, 2018 all staff will be required to have a comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file prior to beginning work and being present at a center at any time when children are present.

The center director stated First Steps Infant / Toddler Center is housing staff and children from The Lighthouse Early Start Academy One until remodeling is complete.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.
