If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

- •3rd Left Classroom: Plastic bags were observed accessible to children hanging on and in children's cubbies.
- •4th Right A Classroom: A stapler was observed accessible to children on the Manipulatives shelf and a plastic bag was observed accessible to children on the writing area shelf.
- •4th Right B Classroom: A plastic bag was observed accessible to children on a portable file box on the floor.
