All equipment and furniture shall be used only by the ageappropriate group of children. It was determined based on observation that there were five infants sitting in high chairs in Room 109 and none of the infants were buckled into the high chairs and they were not used in a safe and appropriate manner and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

The Center will ensure Staff are trained in and children are taught the proper use of all furniture, materials and equipment; will implement a plan for this information to be reviewed with both groups on an ongoing basis; and for monitoring proper and age-appropriate usage.
