Comments

An Administrative Review was conducted on September 18, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 29, 2020 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on May 12, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection. Consultant discussed proposed rule revisions with the Director on this date.

Consultant disucssed an amendment to add an additional infant/toddler playground to licensed capacity.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
