
3) Specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, along with your concerns or questions regarding the rule citation

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.03(7)(a) requires a center that operates five hours or more per day to provide at least one and onehalf hours of outdoor activity per day, weather permitting, for each child who is not an infant and at least one hour daily for infants. It was determined based on observation that the infant room had a schedule documenting that the infants went outside for thirty minutes, one hour is required.
