The purpose of of this visit was to conduct a Licensing Study visit. This visit was conducted in person by the consultant on February 15, 2022.

An Administrative Review for an annual inspection was completed on February 22, 2022. Requested documents for a Licensing Study were revewed by the consultant.

An Exit Conference via telephone was conducted by the Consultant and the Director on February 23, 2022. Consulant emailed report requesting a signature and to be returned within two business days.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.
