- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Please see GBI's website located at http://gbi.georgia.gov to access the Georgia Sex Offender Registry.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.35(3) requires the Center to maintain Staff: child ratios as follows to provide proper supervision of children engaged in swimming and water-related activities in water over two feet deep: Under 2 1/2 years = 1:2, 2 1/2 to 4 years = 1:5, 4 years and older who cannot swim a distance of 15 yards unassisted = 1:6, 4 years and older who can swim a distance of 15 yards unassisted as determined by a swimming test = 1:15. At least one qualified lifequard must be present. Copies of certificates from a recognized water-safety class may be accepted in lieu of requiring each child to take a swimming test to determine if the child can swim 15 yards unassisted. It was determined based on review of records that copies lifeguard certificates were not present for review for one field trip to the Cumming Aquatic Center on July 24, 2019.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that adequate numbers of Staff are available to maintain the required Staff:child ratios. Staff will determine each child's swimming ability by performing a swim test and document the results of the test or will obtain copies of certificates from recognized water safety instructors for children not tested at the Center. A certified lifeguard will be present at the pool during swimming activities.

Finding

591-1-1-.35(6) requires the Parents' written permission for a child to participate in a swimming activity. It was determined based on review of records that parent's written permission for a child to participate in swimming activities was not obtained for children who attended a field trip to the Cumming Aquatic Center on July 24, 2019.

The Center will ensure that parental permission is secured prior to a child's participation.

591-1-1-.15(3) requires baby bottles and formula to be labeled with the individual child's name; supplied by the Parent daily in bottles; and refrigerated at a temperature of forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or less. Only the current day's formula or breast milk shall be served. If formula must be provided by the Center, only commercially prepared, ready-to-feed formula shall be used. Refrigerated or frozen breast milk shall only be heated or thawed under warm running water or in a container of warm water. It was determined based on observation that the baby bottles in infant room 1L were not labeled with the child's name.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff to follow the required procedures, ensure that parents are fully informed, and will review and monitor regularly.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(3)(a-b) requires any Center that provides any type of transportation to obtain two (2) hours of state-approved or state-accepted transportation training, biannually, for the Director and for each person responsible for or who participates in the transportation of children. The training shall include, but is not limited to, a review of the transportation rules, a review of approved transportation forms and procedures, and instruction on the usage and completion of the forms and procedures. This training may be counted as part of the annual training requirements for Staff. It was determined based on review of records that employee who has driven the bus has not has transportation training since 2015.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that the Director, Center Staff, and any person responsible for the transportation of children has completed the required transportation training.

The center will ensure that each vehicle has a working fire extinguisher and that the fire extinguisher is kept out of reach of children.

It was determined based on review of records that one employee with hire date of 4/6/17 and clearance date of 4/12/2017 had not been electronically ported.

IMMÉDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will ensure that only the most recently issued determination letter is electronically ported for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, excluding Students-in-Training. A Center may accept a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination letter or a satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination letter issued by the Department if the Records Check Clearance Date is within the preceding 12 months from the hire date, the individual has not had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, and the Center does not know or reasonably should not know that the individual's satisfactory status has changed. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Center will ensure CRC rules are maintained.
