Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation that on the Three-Year-Olds Playground in Building Two, it was observed that two mops were hanging on the fence where the pole and handles were accessible to children. There was also a drainage pipe with sharp edges accessible in the outdoor area on the entrance to the playground in Building Two.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there were exposed tree roots and rocks on the main building playground and building II playground. Additionally, there was an excess of tree limbs and pine combs on the main building playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Previously Cited: To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will remove the mops from hanging where the poles and handles are accessible to children and the drainage pipe will be repaired.

The center will remove the tree limbs and pine combs, and will cover or paint the exposed tree roots and rocks. The center will, additionally, routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
