Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

591-1-1-.26 - The consultant discussed the maintenance of the painted metal areas of the slide structures and fluffing and redistributing the resilient surfaces beneath the fall zones on the main building playground.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there were exposed tree roots and rocks on the main building playground behind the swings, under the swings, and to the left of the slide structure. Additionally, there was trash inside of the yellow tunnel on the far left side of the main building playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will cover or paint the exposed tree roots and rocks. The center will, additionally, routinely monitor the playground and will remove the trash from inside of the yellow tunnel.

It was determined based on a review of records that the center had three staff hired more than ninety days without documentation of the required health and safety training.
