#### Comments

An Administrative Review was conducted on October 16, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on October 19, 2020 with the director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. #### Finding

591-1-1-.36(7)(d)2. requires that the second designated Staff person conduct a check of the vehicle immediately upon the completion of the first check of the vehicle. The responsible person shall physically walk through the entire vehicle; visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; and sign the passenger transportation checklist(s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle. There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. It was determined based on a review of records that the driver signed for the first and second checks following AM transportation on October 5, 2020 and October 7, 2020 to Woodward Mill Elementary School as well as on October 7, 2020, following PM transportation to Rocksprings Elementary School. Staff statements indicated that additional staff were present at the center who could have conducted the second check of the vehicle and document the check with a signature. It was also determined that on October 13, 2020, and October 14, 2020, a second check was not documented following AM and PM transportation to Woodward Mill Elementary School, as well as on October 14, 2020, following PM transportation to Rocksprings Elementary School.
