Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation in the outdoor play area that the following were observed: The three swing chains on the upper playground were rusted.

A net was attached to the monkey bars and swing set posing a choking hazard on the upper playground...

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there was an active ant bed around the base of the tree near the yellow bus. Further, there was two inches of mulch under the swings and monkey bars when six inches was required. In addition, there was rust and chipping paint on the red merry go round and the red sit and ride tricycle equipment.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Previously Cited: To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will sand and repaint the chains and also remove the net.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

The center director showed documentation for the equipment to be painted on September 23, 2017.
