Finding

591-1-1-.30(2)(c) requires that infants shall not sleep in equipment other than safety-approved cribs, such as, but not limited to, a car safety seat, bouncy seat, highchair, or swing. Infants who arrive at the Center asleep or fall asleep in such equipment, on the floor or elsewhere, shall be transferred to a safety-approved crib. It was determined based on observation that upon arrival at 8:50 A.M. an infant was observed to be asleep in an infant swing. The consultant asked the staff if the infant had just fallen asleep and was told that they had. The consultant waited to see if the teacher would remove the child from the infant swing and place them in a crib. At 8:55 A.M. the consultant asked the teacher to move the infant to a crib and the teacher complied.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will only place infants in safe cribs to sleep and will transfer them to a safe crib when the infants are asleep in other equipment.
