## Finding

591-1-1-.30(4). requires that if cots and mats are stored in the children's activity room or area, they shall be stored to prevent children's access to them and to allow maximum use of play space. When storage is available and used for the storage of cots and mats that allows the cots, mats and any bedding to be stored without touching any other cots, mats or bedding, the bedding may be left on the cot or mat. When such storage is not available for the cots and mats, each child's bedding shall be kept separate from other children's bedding and stored in containers marked for individual use, such as, but not limited to, bins, cubbies, or bags. It was determined based upon the consultant's observation that several blankets in room 46 by the back window sill and 47 on a shelf on the right side of the classroom were touching increasing the potential for the spread of germs.

The Center will store the blankets in the children's cubbies.

# 591-1-1-.09 Criminal Records Check(CR)

### Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(i) requires that if the Center accept a satisfactory determination letter issued by the Department for a potential Director or Employee as evidence of that individual's Satisfactory Records Check Determination, the Records Check Clearance Date must be within the preceding 12 months from the hire date, and the Center does not know or reasonably should not know that the individual's satisfactory status has not changed. It was determined based on a review of records that an employee hired on April 23, 2018, had a Satisfactory Records Check Determination letter that was not dated within the previous 12 months. The employee's Satisfactory Records Check Determination letter was transferable until December 30, 2017.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that each potential Employee bringing a satisfactory determination letter issued by the Department has a Satisfactory Records Check Determination that is dated within the preceding 12 months from the hire date. The Center will not employ individual's whose satisfactory status has changed. An-one-day letter was left on this date. While the consultant was on site, the director was completing the steps for the employee to get her fingerprint run.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.33(2) requires the initial orientation to include the following subjects: the Center's policies and procedures; the portions of these rules dealing with the care, health and safety of children; the Employee's assigned duties and responsibilities; reporting requirements for suspected cases of child abuse, neglect or deprivation; communicable diseases and serious injuries; emergency plans; childhood injury control; the administration of medicine; reducing the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS); hand washing; fire safety; water safety; and prevention of HIV/Aids and blood borne pathogens.
