Comments

September 24, 2019 - The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Complaint Investigation and follow up from previous visit conducted on February 5, 2019. The person in charge informed this Consultant that the regional consultant had just left the center, 30 minutes prior to this consultant conducting the complaint investigation and follow up visit. This consultant was unable to use the laptop due to a technical issue. This consultant explained that the center would be re-cited for the playground - resilient surfacing. This consultant observed four employees in the center, and their first and last names were recorded in order to complete the Comprehensive background checks upon this consultant's laptop being repaired. This report was completed and emailed to the center on September 25, 2019, upon the repair of this consultant's laptop. The signature pages will be signed and dated for September 24, 2019, the date the visit was conducted.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS).

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Findings Report

Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation that the resilient surface (wood chips) on the playground, under the swings closest to the left side of the fence measured 1/4 of an inch.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency. Center stated that the center was getting rid of the swings near the fence. Center stated that the center added resilient surface to the slide structure on the playground, not the swing set closest to the fence.
