An Administrative Review was conducted on October 15, 2020. Previous citations, core rules, and background checks were all reviewed. A head count / walk through was conducted on October 15, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020 was reviewed and discussed via phone with the Director. New BFTS rules were reviewed and emailed to the provider on this date.

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O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
