It was determined based on the consultant's review of records that a staff member did not complete first aid and CPR within 90 days of their hire date.

The Center will develop a schedule to ensure there is always a staff person with current first aid and CPR training present and will develop and implement a plan to ensure all staff members have satisfactorily completed first aid and CPR training by the specified date.
