If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

591-1-1-.12(2) requires that all equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint; and be kept clean. It was determined based on observed that the following equipment was in hazardous conditions

Playground Deck: Broken red chair, caterpillar radio flyer riding toy, red tricyle with split rubber tire on front Playground Rear Right: On the bike merry go round there was three torn seats with exposed wood and foam, two with missing pedals. the red tunnel had chipping paint The green car had two missing steering wheels.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that equipment and furniture are used by the age-appropriate group of children.

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the bottom fencing on the right rear playground had a hole measuring at approximately ten inches wide and six inches high which pose an entrapment hazard.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and will repair any hazards.

## Correction Deadline: 3/20/2018

## **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation that the fall zone for the swings had inadequate resilient surface in that six inches was required and only two inches was observed.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.

# Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the follow hazards were observed:

- -there were two wooded panels on the deck playground that was broken an protruding outwards with sharp edges.
- -the tarp underneath the swings was exposed and posed a tripping hazard..
- -the tarp at the orange top was exposed an posed a tripping hazard.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will fix on the playground and will routinely monitor the playground for hazards.
