However, as stated above, any violations of identical rule(s) will require the department to treat any and all additional rule violations identified in the investigation as repeated rule violations.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. 591-1-1-.17(3) requires that children's combs, toothbrushes and cloth towels be kept clean. It was determined based on the center director's statement and the statement of a staff member that on March 5, 2021 a elevenmonth-old infant was given the wrong bottle resulting in the infant being fed breast milk instead of formula.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop a plan to ensure these items are kept clean, that includes training staff and monitoring for compliance. The center director purchased a refrigerator specifically for this classroom to use in the future.
