In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on a review of records that four out of five children's records reviewed did not have the required enrollment information.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will develop a plan that includes how to obtain all required information for currently enrolled children and how to ensure this is done for future enrollees as well. The plan will also include how and where to maintain files for the required amount of time. The plan will be implemented and followed.

# **Finding**

It was determined based on a review of records that the director and driver of the transportation vehicle did not have transportation training as required.

The Center will ensure that the Director, Center Staff, and any person responsible for the transportation of children has completed the required transportation training.

It was determined based on a review of records that two out of tour staff members did not have evidence of completing ten hours of annual training in 2017.

The Center will plan and schedule the required 10 hours of annual training each year and follow up to ensure the training is completed.
