If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

#### **Technical Assistance**

Consultant discussed that two mushrooms were observed on the left playground that need to be removed before children go outside to play.

Consultant discussed the bottom of the gate between the front left and back left was not secured and had sharp metal edges.

#### Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resilient. It was determined based on observation that the large metal equipment on the back right playground was observed to be inadequate in that approximately one inch of resilient surfacing was observed.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily.
