Finding

591-1-1-.25(11) requires that floor coverings be tight, smooth, free of odors and washable or cleanable. Floors throughout the entire building did not meet these requirements in that in each classroom the consultant observed multiple tiles cracked.

It was determined based on observation that during a visit at the center on July 14, 2017, the consultant observed multiple crack tiles throughout the hallway and in the classroom C.

It was determined based on observation that during a visit at the center on January 29, 2018., the consultant observed multiple crack tiles throughout the hallway and in the classroom C.

It was determined based on observation that during a visit at the center on April 27, 2018, the consultant observed pictures covering all the areas of the floors throughout the center as a temporary fix. Some areas of the floor were uneven and pose a tripping hazard. The center has a made request to replace floor tiles and have set the date of May 31, 2018.

Floors will be maintained to be safe and sanitary.
