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Findings Report

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The following information is associated with a Complaint Investigation Follow Up:

Facility

591-1-1-.19 License Capacity(CR)

Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.19(1) requires a Center to provide 35 square feet of usable space per child, which will determine the Center's License capacity. It was determined based on observation that upon the consultant's arrival at the center, there were 15 children, ages infants to school age, being cared for in classroom A which was licensed for eight children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will limit the number of children in this space to the licensed capacity.

Staffing and Supervision

591-1-1-.32 Staff: Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)

Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.32(3) requires a Center with a licensed capacity of 18 or fewer children to maintain Staff-child ratios in mixed-age groups of children under three years old based on the age of the youngest child under three years of age. Where all of the children in any one group are three years of age or older, the age of the majority of the children in the group shall determine the Staff: child ratios. It was determined based on consultant observation that three staff were required to be present with the children and consultant observed there to be only one staff present. Consultant observed there to be 15 children present. Of those children, there was one infant observed, three were observed to be one year old, seven were observed to be two years old, and four were observed to be ages five years to nine years of age.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will determine and maintain Staff: child ratios as required.

Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on observation that upon the consultant's arrival, there was one staff member present with a total of 18 children. Three of the children, ages four years, were observed to be napping in classroom B without supervision. The one staff member present was observed to be in classroom A with the other 15 children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
