The consultant observed in Room C, a wooden toy microwave on top of a wooden toy fridge. The microwave was not secured and presented a tipping and falling hazard. The room was unoccupied during the visit. The Director will ensure the toy microwave is moved to a different location or secured before children in care are back in Room C.

It was determined based on observation that there were eight children in a room licensed for four children. The Director stated that a staff member was out sick and two rooms were combined. Additionally, it was determined based on observation that the center was over total capacity due to thirteen children being present and the center's total capacity @ 35 square feet being for twelve children.
