It was determined based on the consultant's review that children's records were incomplete in that:

\*One of four children was missing a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program.

It was determined based on the consultant's observation that children did not wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water after morning snack. It was further determined based on the consultant's observation that children did not wash their hands when moving from one classroom to another while the owner /director was cooking lunch.
