Finding

591-1-1-.08(1) requires the Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled. In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on a review of children's records that one of five record's was missing the father's work address and one of five record's was missing the home address for the release person.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff ensure children's applications are completed in its entirety to include identifying information about the Parent(s) to include names of both parents, if applicable, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers: names and addresses of person(s) to whom the child may be released. Such information shall contain the authorized persons address, telephone numbers, relationship to the child and to the parent(s), and other identifying information.
