#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.25(3) requires that the Center and surrounding premises be clean, free of debris and in good repair. It was determined based on consultants observation that the following areas were observed to be noncompliant:

- -the floors and baseboards within the kitchen have dirt build-up.
- -outside window seal outside the front left room was observed to be chipping paint
- -a rail on the front porch was not secure with an exposed nail
- -the lattice under the center was not secure on the playground
- -on the right side of the front left room a nail was exposed near the infant crib

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will ensure the screens are repaired.

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resilient. It was determined based on consultant observation that the yellow and blue slide did not have adequate fall zone as it was placed approximately three and a half feet away from the PVC piping.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resilient.

#### **Finding**

- -Paint at the top of the blue and yellow slide was observed to be chipping paint
- -the yellow, blue and purple play equipment had a crack in the yellow slide
- -the yellow, blue, red and green play equipment had a crack in the tunnel
