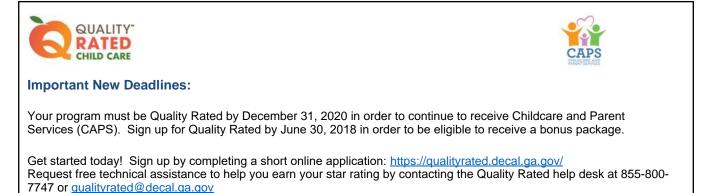

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. ## 591-1-1-.09 Criminal Records Check(CR)

#### Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(a) requires the Center to ensure that every Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of the Child Care Learning Center has a satisfactory records check determination before the individual is present at the Center or before the individual resides in a Center. It was determined based on staff statement that one (1) employee did not have a satisfactory records check determination letter before being present at the center.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will obtain the Required Satisfactory Records Check Determination before an individual is present at the Center while any child is present for care or before residing in a Center.

## 591-1-1-.24 Personnel Records

## Finding

.24(2) requires Personnel files to also contain daily attendance records or other employee payroll records for the Employee for the preceding six (6) month period which may be stored away from the Center provided that the Center notifies the Department of its intention to store these records off-site, provides the Department with the name, address and phone number of the custodian of these records and allows the Department, at its discretion, to have access to these records at the custodian's location immediately or access at the Center within seven (7) business days of a Department representative's request. The Department may, at its discretion, accept photocopies of the requested records which are provided within seven (7) business days of the Department representative's request for the same;. It was determined based on staff statement that one (1) person did not have a personnel file on site for consultant review as requested.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

Within seven business days, the Center will submit photocopies of requested records or have these available at the Center for review. The Center will ensure the Department's access to personnel records according to these rules.

## Finding

591-1-1.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on review of video from April 23, 2018 that seven children age one (1) in the infant room was left unsupervised when the teacher and the director left the classroom. It was further found that one child in the infant room crawled out of the room.
