If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.32(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined based on observation that there was a total of eight children and one staff member present for a ratio of 1:8. The ages of the children were 2-infants under 12 months, 2 - one-year-olds, and 4 two-year-olds. Based on the age of the youngest group that includes more than twenty percent which were the infants, the ratio should have been 1:6 and not 1:8.
